## Our Judge Tony Lyons (Elsworth)

Tony combined his career in broadcasting with running his breeding and show kennels of Yorkshire Terriers and later Pomeranians.

On his 4<sup>th</sup> birthday his parents presented him with a pedigree Wire fox Terrier puppy. Some years later he acquired a Sealyham terrier which he exhibited.

He worked from age 17 in Local Government in the Midlands before moving to Dublin to take a degree in Arts and Commerce at UCD. In 1962 he was recruited and trained as an announcer by the then Radio Eireann. He was on the announcing team from 1962 to 1965 when he was recruited by the then Telefis Eirean as the first information officer with the infant television service.

He purchased his first home in Rathfarnham in 1963 and there he started his first kennel of Yorkshire Terriers. His first show dog was also his foundation bitch and all his Yorkshire Champions were descended from her. She was CH and Annual CH Elsworth Amber Pearl who during her show career won 6 Toy Groups, a BIS, 2 RBIS as well as the 40 Green Star points necessary for CH title under the old system. In the UK she won a RBIS at a club show in London and 4 days later she won the CC, BOB and a Group 4 at the LKA.

For her first mating she was mated to the UK champion Deebees Cornish Echo and although only 4 lbs she self- whelped the Champion twins Ch Elsworth Amber Gambler and CH Elsworth Amber Whisper who won two Toy Groups and was an Annual Champion. They both produced a Champion each.

In all he bred and campaigned 10 Champion Yorkshire Terriers. Two of them won CC's, one had one CC and the other had two CC's. The majority of the champions were also Annual Champions.

Later, he added Pomeranians to his Kennels. He bred and campaigned three of his second generation home bred Pomeranians to their titles of Champion, including the twins' CH Elsworth Sunshine Boy and CH Elsworth Sunglow. Mr Lyons has awarded Challenge Certificates in the UK and has judged extensively in Ireland and the UK.

We are delighted to welcome Tony to judge our show and we wish him a very enjoyable day.

## SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS

1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Date:** The Show will be held on **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2018** at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin.  
**ENTRY FEES:** € 8.00 for the first dog, € 4.00 for each additional dog, Brace € 4.00. Entries in Brace must be also entered in the Breed Class.
3. **ENTERING EXHIBITS:** Entries will be received up to and **including 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2018 (postmark)**. **29<sup>th</sup> June 2018 online [www.dogshowentry.ie](http://www.dogshowentry.ie)** Entries must be made on the form issued for this purpose. **ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
4. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry,
5. **REGISTRATIONS:** All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
6. **ROSETTES:** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class, to Green Star winners, and Best of Breed, Best Puppy, Best Veteran
7. **PRIZES WITHHELD:** A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his (or her) opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
8. **CATALOGUES:** will be free of charge to exhibitors, otherwise €2.
9. **JUDGES:** If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge.
10. **JUDGING:**
  - (a) Will commence at after **12.30pm**
  - (b) No person will be allowed in the Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
  - (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
  - (d) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

**FOULING:** A minimum fine of €50.00 shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.

### CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*\*\*\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

\*\*\*\* Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.\*\*

**N.B.:** A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

**NOTE:** Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
