Show Regulations

ENTRY FEES: €8.00 (£8.00Stg) for First Dog (to include Car Park) €4.00 (£4.00Stg) for subsequent Dogs or Classes.

Entries will be accepted up to and including 29th September 2017

Online entry closes at midnight on the 6th October, 2017

PRIZES: Rosettes will be given to Best in Show, Best Opposite Sex, Reserve in each Sex, and First, Second, Third and Reserve in each class. Trophies to be competed for by Club Members only.

JUDGING: Judging will commence at 12.00 noon sharp. Should either of the appointed Judges fail to keep their appointment, the Committee reserve the right to appoint a suitable substitute.

No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or any exhibitor taking their Dog in for adjudication. The Exhibition No. of each Dog must be clearly displayed by its handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging ring.

Under no circumstances may the order of Judging as provided for in the Catalogue be departed from. The Show will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring though the exhibit may be on its appointed bench at the time of judging.

CATALOGUES: The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss, direct or indirect occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue. Such mistake should be reported to the ring Steward if judging is in progress, otherwise the exhibitor should report the inaccuracy to the Secretary immediately. Catalogues will be on sale at €2.00. each

ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE: The promoting body will accept no responsibility for any loss or damage sustained by exhibits or other persons attending the Show through accident or otherwise.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED SHOWS

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Minor Puppy Class is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. (.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth..

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Restricted / Special Classes (i.e. Colour Classes etc) The dog must be entered in one of the standard classes scheduled for the breed, as above.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
