We are very please to introduce our International panel of Judges:

Regina Bachmann (Germany)

Hello friends of the Deutsche Dogge, I would like to introduce myself. My name is Regina Bachmann and I am 50 years old. Since 1996, my husband and I keep Deutsche Doggen. The Deutsche Dogge has fascinated me for decades, and it was actually a logical



consequence that I joined the Deutscher Doggen Club and subsequently engaged myself for the benefit of the breed. This commitment finally led to the Deutsche Doggen kennel "Buccaneer's", which I lead together with my husband Rüdiger. We breed fawns, brindles, harlequins and black Deutsche Doggen.

In 2013, I was elected to the executive committee of the Deutscher Doggen Club 1888 e.V. (DDC), first as vice president and since 2015 as president, through tasks in local and regional groups and breeding and watchdog activities. The DDC is the Club that



manages the FCI Deutsche Dogge (Great Dane) Standard. Also since 2015, I am the chairman of the EUDDC Breeding and Health Commission and in some other cynological committees. Some time later, I started my two-year Special Education training to become a breed judge, which I completed in early 2017. Furthermore, I am responsible for the training of breeders of the DDC.

I get involved with all my strength and my commitment to the breeding of healthy Deutsche Doggen according to the standard. And not only in my function as president of the DDC and breeder, but also as a breeding judge.

Eric Bailey (GB)

I have owned Danes for 45 years Exhibiting C.C and Res. C.C winning Fawns and Brindles, my wife of 41 years, Gina also had a blue before we married .

I am a Vice President of The Great Dane Breeders and Owners Association. I have a large collection of Great Dane Memorabilia charting the history of our wonderful breed.

As a family we also kept a number of Whippets from both Show, Racing and Coursing stock. We also have family links with Schipperke's Borzoi's and curly Coated Retrievers.

I first awarded C.C.'s in 1985, I have also had the privilege of judging The Dane of the Year Show and officiating over all five colours for the Duitse Doggen Club in Holland. I am looking forward to judging in Ireland a country I have never had the pleasure to visit.



Lourdes Caprajaval (USA)

My love affair with Great Danes started as a child, but it was not until the 1970's that I acquired my first Gentle Giant, a Rescue named Morisca Moon of Carpa, CD who allowed me to share in her infinite wisdom. Danes then became my passion and in the late 1970's, I was in the show ring. My successes in the Breed have been many for which I am very grateful and under the kennel name Rochford, together with Janet Quick, we have been committed to the



health, longevity and quality of Great Danes. However, we do not breed anymore. I have been very actively involved in Puerto Rico and the United States in dog legislation, animal abuse laws, responsible ownership through the public school system, Great Dane Rescue, Chairperson of National Specialties, the Board of GDCA and have also administered the GDCA Charitable Trust, but it is as a judge, that I feel I have culminated my dedication to Great Danes as I can give, with my opinion, something back to the Breed that I have chosen to dedicate my life to. We show actively with great success be it owner handled or at the level of campaigning a Dane, with the help of handlers. I feel most fortunate for my successes in the Breed as an owner and judge. I love this Breed and my dedication will always be there in every aspect.

Mrs Milena Franzetti (Italy).

I'm addicted to the dogs world since I was a child, and I has been loved and owned by mixed breeds and German Shepherds. When I met my husband I had my first contact with the Great Danes and they still are a BIG part of my life!

I had my first Great Dane in 1987, my breeding started in 1999 with a fawn litter, my kennel name (Lotosdanes) was approved in 2003. Since then I have bred few litters with the aim to produce Danes adherent to the standard, healthy, correct and with good temperament. I have produced a good number of champions if related to the very few puppies born in my kennel since the beginning.

Since 1987 I was involved in the breed club, I have been a member of the directive board for many years and now I am a member of the Technical Committee of the club. Furthermore, I am the vice president of the kennel club in Monza, my local Italian kennel club delegation and I'm in charge of the annual show organization. Since 2010 I am a dog show judge for Great Danes (for my breed I am also a tutor judge for the beginners) and now I judge many breeds of the Group 2, all the Group 4 and almost all the Italian breeds. I am a judge also for CAE-1, a temperament test. I have judges in many European countries some very important shows as the EuDDC show, the Interclub Championship and many Club Championships.



Jean-François Martin (France).

As a child, I was raised with dogs, and then studies made me more or less distant. It is only after my marriage that this passion developed and I created in 1968 my breeding of Deutsche Dogge under the affix of Fauvelles. Many champions came from my breeding and my origins and I had to stop for professional reasons in 1991.

I was appointed Regional Delegate in 1973 and I returned to the Board of Directors of the Doggen Club of France, the French Club of the Great Dane, as a member and then vice-president and president in 1997, a position that I still occupies today.

I was named a judge in 1983 for the Great Dane breed and then I expanded into a few breeds of the second group that I particularly liked, so that I only judge breeds I like.



IGDC /EuDDC Confirmation

Standardised Assessment for Breeding

In conjunction with IGDC Club Winners and EuDDC 2019 Shows

We will continue to give you the opportunity to all responsible breeders to have your Great Danes assessed for breeding using the EuDDC approved assessment format. Only Danes which have passed their assessment will be eligible to go on the EuDDC breeding (stud) register.

Dogs and Bitches who succeed in the assessment and have also undergone the requisite health tests will be eligible to go on both the IGDC and EuDDC breeding/conformation registers, [www. EuDDC.org](http://www.EuDDC.org)

You can book your place in the assessment using the show entry form, dogs in the assessment do not necessarily have to be entered in the championship show. Fee for assessment is €60 per dog.

Dogs must be at least 15 months old on the day of the assessment and should preferably have had their health checks done. At present the health check for Hip Dysplasia & Elbows are compulsory, Dogs should have valid DCM certificate at time of mating.

Please bring copies of your dogs Registration Certificate and All Health Check Certificates to the assessment. Dogs may be provisionally assessed subject to Health Checks being completed in the near future. Dogs cannot pass the assessment until copies of their Health Certificates have been provided.

Please note before being assessed by the judges, each dog will undergo an initial health check by our vet. This will include a scan for the microchip identification.

Dog must be identifiable by Microchip.

Heart Scans available at the show.

Veterinary Cardiologist Serena Brownlie PhD BVM&S MRCVS Cert SAC has kindly agreed to carry out Heart testing on site, tests will include Full Doppler, DCM and ECG .

Dog must be identifiable by Microchip and you must bring copy of you dogs Registration Certificate.

Bookings must be made in advance, every effort will be made to ensure there is on clash with classes dogs that are entered in show.

Heart Scan is also open to dogs not entered in the show, as well as other breeds.

Class Definitions

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word "dog" denotes both sexes)

A BABY PUPPY CLASS is confined to dogs of four months and under six months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. Baby puppies cannot compete in any other class

A PUPPY CLASS is confined to dogs of six months and under twelve months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

A JUNIOR CLASS is for dogs between nine months and eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

AN INTERMEDIATE CLASS is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

AN OPEN CLASS is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A CHAMPIONS CLASS is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**

A VETERAN CLASS is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

A PROGENY CLASS to be judged on the merits of progeny a sire or dam with minimum three and maximum five of his progeny (first generation, sons/daughters). Progeny must be present at, and entered in, at least one class at this Show.

A BREEDERS CLASS consisting of minimum three and maximum five exhibits of the same breed and variety, without distinction of sex, bred by the same person (same kennel name), even if they are not his property. each exhibit having been entered in one of the standards classes on the day.

A BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team

A TEAM CLASS is for three, or more, exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person,

NOTE: *Dogs under the age of 4 months are not eligible to compete at this Show. All dogs must be registered or transferred at The Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor
The Irish Kennel Club will impose a fine of € 100 for those failing to comply with this regulation.*

Show Regulations

- JURISDICTION:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force at closing date of entries.
- JUDGING:** Will commence at **12:00 noon**.
- JUDGE:** In the event of our appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge.
- REGISTRATION:** All dogs, entered, for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at The Irish Kennel Club Ltd., Greenmount Park, Dublin 6W.
- INTERPRETATION:** The Committee of The Irish Great Dane Club shall be the "Show Committee" within the meaning of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules and all disputes, (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to The Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- During the exhibition of dogs, the Judge Officiating will **not** allow, under any circumstances, any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
