Show Regulations:

1. JURISDICTION

The show will be held under licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. As in force on 20th August 2017. All dogs must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

2. Venue

The show will be held at Ferryhouse Sports Complex, Waterford Road, Clonmel, Co. Tipperary on Sunday 20th August 2017, between the hours of 11am and 6pm. Judging will commence at 12 noon.

3. Entries will be received up to and including 21st July 2017 by the secretary: Mr K Croarkin, Wheatfield Road, Palmerstown, Dublin 20. Tel: 087 7860157. The promoting body shall have the right to refuse any entry.

4. ENTRIES

Entry Fee of €18 for first entry and €9 for each dog thereafter.

Stakes Classes €5.00 per class

There will be an entry fee of €5 for Special classes, **exhibits entered in Special classes must also be entered in a standard breed class.**

No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

4. JUDGING

If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her appointment, the committee reserves to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the promoting body to change a judge in a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.

5. The promoting body shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any dog in the ring. In the event of an exhibitor requesting a Steward or other official to handle his or her exhibit in the ring, any such official may voluntarily do so but on the distinct understanding that such an action is on behalf of the owner and does not involve the promoting body in any responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage consequential or otherwise.

JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 12 NOON SHARP.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'dog' denotes both sexes)

A BABY PUPPY CLASS – is for dogs over four months and under six months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition.

A MINOR PUPPY CLASS – is for dogs over six months and under nine months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

PUPPY CLASS - is confined to dogs over six months and under twelve months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A JUNIOR CLASS - is confined to dogs over nine months and under eighteen months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A INTERMEDIATE CLASS – is confined to dogs over fifteen months and under twenty four months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

AN OPEN CLASS - is for dogs over fifteen months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A VETERAN CLASS - is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

A SPECIAL OPEN CLASS - As for open but restricted as to colour.

CHAMPION CLASS is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Limited rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

A BRACE CLASS - is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

A TEAM CLASS - is for three or more exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
