SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Date:** The Show will be held on **Saturday 10th September 2017** in the pavilion at Balmoral Park, Maze, Lisburn.
3. **ENTRY FEES:** €8.00 (£8.00) for the first dog, €4.00 (£4.00) for each subsequent dog. **Champion Stakes €8.00 (£8.00)**
4. **ENTERING EXHIBITS:** Entries will be received up to and **including 20th April 2017 (postmark) and online www.dogshowentry.ie** at midnight the **24th April 2017**

- ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
5. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry,
6. **REGISTRATIONS:** All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
7. **ROSETTES:** will be given to All Best of Breeds, Best in Show, Res. Best in Show, Best Baby Puppy, Best Puppy in Show, Best Junior in Show, Best Intermediate in Show. Champion Stakes.
8. **JUDGES:** If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge.
9. **JUDGING:**
 - (a) **Will not commence before 1.00pm** . No claim will be considered for any exhibit arriving late.
 - (b) No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
 - (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
 - (d) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
10. **Accident or damage:** The promoting body will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise. (b) The promoting body will not be responsible for any accident, that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the Show.
11. **Champion Stakes, winner £15.00, Second £10.00, Third £5.00. To be judged after Best in Show**

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)
