## OUR JUDGE

### **Ms. Hannah Walder (Hanvale)**

My Mum began the Hanvale kennel in 1983 but the first Rough Collie I had of my own was Lanteague Amanda at Brilyn. Brian Hawkins offered her to my Mum who bought her as a 3 year old for my tenth birthday present in 1987 for me to show. We were an inseparable pair and together we won 4 CCs & 1 RCC. She is the Great Great Grandmother of our Ch Hanvale Doogie Howser who is now 12 years old himself and retired from the showing. He was the first homebred Hanvale Champion and gained an identical haul to Amanda of 4CCs and 1RCC in his show career.

I had a few years out of the ring while I went to university in London then in 2004 I married Simon who had always had dogs but never shown. My degree is in Osteopathy and I specialise in lower limb biomechanics - though I knew the anatomy of a dog long before that of a human. I am also now a Canine Osteopath.

In 2012, we imported Florence from France from the Cabrenysset Kennel, which was established some 75 years ago. Florence has become quite well known in the U.K. and was a champion at two years old. She now holds 9CCs and 4RCCs with the title of the British Collie Club Rough Collie of the Year 2013 and Runner Up in both 2015 and 2016.

In 2016, I went full circle and was offered 'Bella' by Brian Hawkins, who let me have Amanda some 29 years earlier. She gained her Junior Warrant at just 14 months, her first CC at 15 months plus two Breed Club Best in Show awards before giving us the most beautiful litter of three babies from which we have kept Hanvale Polly Shelby. On returning to the ring after her litter, she gained the RCC at her first show back out, then Best in Show at the West of England Collie Society, CC at Belfast and RCC at the Collie Association, all in just three months. She was then the British Collie Club Runner Up Rough Collie of the Year 2018.

I had my first Rough Collie judging appointment when I was 14 and now award CCs in the breed. I am assistant Secretary of the Midland Collie Club.

## **DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW**

**(All age classes computed from date of birth.)**

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

**Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

**Minor Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show .

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, .

**An Adult Class** is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

**Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

**N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)**

**BRACE CLASS** is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

**Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.**

All class winners graded excellent are eligible to challenge for the green Star.

**Please NOTE** that the Officers, Committee and your fellow exhibitors would and will appreciate it if everybody disposed of their litter in the bins provided. That includes Dog Coat and Unmentionables.

**YOU DO KNOW** that is an offence under I.K.C. rules not to clean up after the latter and there is a €50.00 fine for failing to do so, which will be enforced.

**JURISDICTION :** The show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force at the date of publication of this schedule.

**REGISTRATION :** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the I.K.C., Fottrell House, Unit 36 Greenmount Office Pk., Harolds Cross Bridge, 6W

**VENUE :** The show will be held at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin  
**On Thursday , 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018**

**ENTRY FEES: €20.00 1<sup>st</sup> Dog, Second & subsequent dogs €6.00 .**

**Any amount @€30.00 in same ownership**

**Entries Close Postal Entries Close 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

**On-Line entries close at midnight on the 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

**JUDGING :** (a) **Judging will commence at 2.00pm.** No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit arriving late. (b) No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each exhibit must be clearly displayed by the handler, who not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring. (e) During the exhibition of dogs , the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify an exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

**JUDGES :** In the event of any appointed judge failing to keep his or her engagement, the committee shall have the right to appoint another judge.
