Show Regulations

1. **The Show** will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
2. **Venue:** The Show will be held in the National Show Centre Cloghran, Co. Dublin, on Saturday 13th May 2017
3. **Judging** will commence at 11.00 am. sharp
4. **No claim** will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late for its class. No person will be allowed into the judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication. The exhibit number of each dog must be displayed by its handler.
5. **In the event** of any appointed judge failing to keep his or her appointment, the Committee reserve the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
6. **The committee** reserve the right to alter the proposed order of judging if this should become necessary.
7. **Entry Fees:** €22.00 for the first dog, €10.00 for each subsequent dog. **Baby Puppy €10.00. Entries will be received up to and including the 21st April 2017**
8. **Enter on line at www.dogshowentry.ie**
Online entry closes at midnight on the 28th April 2017
8. The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advert or other insertion in the Catalogue.
9. **Ineligible Entries:** If before judging of a class or classes in which his dog is entered, an exhibitor reports that he has entered a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the equivalent class or classes for the correct Breed or sex. No other transfer of an ineligible entry is permitted
10. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition at this show must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
11. **A judge** will be empowered to withhold any award, prize or Green Star if in his or her opinion the exhibits are not of sufficient merit..
12. **The Catalogue** will be available on the day of the show. Price €2.00.
13. **Car Park** is Free.
14. **The catalogue** will be compiled from the entry forms and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the Committee cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the IKC Ltd., Rule 15, Section 1, or for clerical errors that may occur during compilation.
15. **The promoting** body will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors, or other persons attending the Show.
16. **The promoting** body shall be the Show Committee and all disputes shall be dealt with by the Show Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the IKC Ltd.
17. **Exhibitors** must clean up after their dogs. Suitable facilities will be provided for this purpose. Any exhibitor found not cleaning up after their dog will be liable to a €30.00 fine.
18. **Ring numbers** will be given out on the day.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

(All age classes computed from date of birth.)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

Minor Puppy Class is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show,

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show,

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.***

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Irish Kennel Club Rule Section 1 Rule Registration

Every dog exhibited or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test, must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of greyhounds, duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club, and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for obedience, agility or working tests. Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event AND (b) the exhibitor being fined one hundred and twenty seven euros (€127), the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the IKC Ltd. Should carry a fee of €6.50 refundable if the appeal is upheld.
