## SHOW REGULATIONS

The Show will be held under the licence, Rules and Regulations of the IKC Ltd, as in force on the date of the publication of the Schedule. All dogs entered for competition must be registered or transferred at the IKC Ltd.

The Show will be held at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin between the hours of 9.30am and 4 pm.

**Judges and Judging.** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge. Judging will commence at 1.30pm No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibitor being late. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibit number for each dog must be clearly displayed by the Handler. The Club shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring. During the exhibition of dogs, the Judge, Officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the Handler.

**Catalogue.** The promoting body shall not be responsible for any loss direct or indirect occasioned by any mistake or omission in the Catalogue,. In any such case the exhibitor should immediately inform the ring steward if the judging is in progress and other- wise report to the Show Secretary.

**Notices.** All announcements will appear in the Tuesday Dog Column of the Evening Herald prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the promoting body in the Schedule or in the Regulations shall be deemed sufficient

notice. The Club will not be responsible for the loss or damage sustained by exhibitors, exhibits or any person attending the Show through accident or otherwise. Parents and Guardians are responsible for children in their care and are expected to supervise them at all times. Those in charge of dogs are expected to clean up after them and there is a fine of €100 for not doing so.

## **CLASSIFICATION for Miniature/ Standard / Giants**

**Dogs:** Baby Puppy, Minor Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Intermediate ,Adult Open, Champion, Veteran

**Bitches:** Baby Puppy, Minor Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Intermediate Adult Open, Champion, Veteran

## **DEFINITION OF CLASSES AT BREED CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW**

**(All age classes computed from date of birth.)**

**Baby Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

**Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

**Minor Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**Adult Class** is for dogs between 24 and 36 months

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth..

**Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

**N.B.:** A Dog or Bitch may be entered in **ONE BREED CLASS ONLY** (No double entries)
