# Rules and Regulations

1. **Jurisdiction:** The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force on the 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018
2. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6
3. **ENTRIES-First dog** €20.00 Euro or Sterling  
**Other dogs** same owner €5.00 Euro or Sterling
4. **Rosettes** in All Classes 1st to 4th.
5. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
6. **Judging:** Will commence at 12.00 noon
7. **A Vet will be on call**
8. The Show Committee will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.

**Ring numbers will be given out on the day**

## CLASSIFICATION

**Dogs:** Baby Puppy Minor Puppy Puppy Junior Intermediate Open Champion Veteran

**Bitches:** Baby Puppy Minor Puppy Puppy Junior Intermediate Open Champion Veteran

## **Gradings**

### **Puppy Class**

The Gradings allowed in these classes are:

- Very Promising
- Promising
- Class winners with **Very Promising** compete for the **Green Star**

### **Junior Class, Intermediate, Open, Champion, Veteran, Field Trial:**

The Gradings allowed in these classes are:

- Excellent
- Very Good
- Good
- Sufficient
- Cannot be judged

There is no need to check the Ages of the dogs.

## **GREEN STARS**

- All Class winners with **Excellent** grade **and in the case of Puppies Very Promising** compete for the **Green Star or Reserve Green Star**
- If an **Excellent** grade is awarded the **Green Star** must also be awarded (i.e. can not be withheld.)
- The Green Star **can be awarded** to a Puppy Class winner graded Very Promising this is at **the judges discretion.**

## CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

**A Baby Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over four and under six calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

**Baby Puppies** are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award

**Minor Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of six months and under nine months of age on the first day of the show.

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**A Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*

**A Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)**
