# Show Rules, Regulations and Instructions to Exhibitors

1. **The Show** will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
2. **Venue:** The Show will be held at **Thurles Rugby Club Grounds, Thurles, Co Tipperary** on **Sunday 2nd May 2010**.
3. **Entry Fee - €20 (€16 Stlg) 1st dog, €6 (€4 Stlg) for each additional dog** in the same ownership. There will be an **additional charge of €4 (€3 Stlg)** each dog for the **Puppy, Champion and Brace Stakes**. For entry in Stake Classes the exhibits **MUST** be entered in a breed class. **Veteran Stakes €6 (€4 Stlg)**, entry in Breed Classes is not required.  
**Junior Handling €6 (€4 Stlg)** per dog if not entered in breed class, **€1** per dog if entered in breed class. Junior Handlers **must be members of The J H A Of Ireland**.  
**Obedience - Beginners, Novice, Graduate, Limit €5 (€3 Stlg)** per dog per class  
**Open €8 (€5 Stlg)** per dog per class

## FREE CAR PARKING

**CATALOGUE €3 (€2 Stlg)** which may be prepaid with entries. **€4 on the day**.

All catalogues pre-paid and if not collected by 11.30 am will be sold.

4. **Entries will be received up to and including 25th March 2010 (postmark) or enter on-line at [www.dogshowentry.ie](http://www.dogshowentry.ie)**  
**On-line entries close at midnight on 6th April 2010.**

UK exhibitors are to be reminded that postage must be correct or the entries will not arrive in time. (Please add an 'E' stamp AND a blue air mail sticker)

5. **Entry Forms : Mistakes** The Catalogue which will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, The South Tipperary Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1 or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
6. **Rejection of Entries:** The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue..
7. **Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed is allowed if reported to the Secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the open class in that breed, but in no other respects.
8. **Registrations:** All dogs entered for competition at this show must be registered at The Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6W. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
9. **Prize Money:** **Best in Show Winner €100 Reserve Best in Show €45 Remaining Group Winners €20 Puppy Stakes €40 2nd €25 3rd €16 4th €10 A.V. Veteran €20 A.V. Brace €20 Junior Handling Classes €10 Prize money will be paid out on the day of the show. Prize cards will be given to 1st to 4th in Classes. Rosettes will be given to Green Star Dog and Bitch, BOB, Reserve Group & Group Winners, Reserve Best in Show, Best In Show, Stakes 1st to 4th, Junior Handlers and Obedience 1st to 4th.**
10. **Prizes Withheld;** A judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes, or Green Stars, if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.

11. **During the exhibition of dogs**, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
12. **Exhibits Not Sent:** Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid.
13. While efforts will be made by the Stewards to see that every eligible dog present at the show will be brought into the Ring when required for judging, the South Tipperary Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.
14. **Veterinary Examination:** Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease (ii) totally blind or deaf (iii) vicious or savage disposition.
15. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his engagement the Committee shall have the right to fill the vacancy thus caused.
16. **Judging: Obedience & Junior Handling** will commence at **9.30 a.m.**  
In all other rings, **Judging** will commence at **10.00 a.m. sharp**, and no claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by his handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring.
17. **Spectators:** Admission: €2.00
18. **Interpretation:** The Guarantors of the South Tipperary Canine Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the I.K.C. Ltd. Rules and all disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the committee. Parties to any disputes shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
19. **The show will be open to the public from 8.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.**
20. **The Promoting Body** will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.

**NOTE Addition To I.K.C. RULE 7 Section 1 - Registration of Dogs**

Addition to above Rule: Failure to comply with the above will result in:

- (A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and (B) The exhibitor being fined €127.00  
The implementation of which shall be a normal (I.K.C.) office routine

All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club  
in the name of the Exhibitor.

**PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW  
AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION NUMBER ON THE ENTRY FORM.**

**PLEASE NOTE:**

Exercise and puppy pens are not allowed in the Showground.  
Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the Showgrounds

## RULES FOR JUDGING

1. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Group (s) or for Best In Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, or for Best In Show, owing to the judging of its breeds not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. An award for Best of Breed shall not be operative for Group judging in the case of any dog from which a prize has been withheld for want of merit.
3. Entry in Group classes will be confined to undefeated winners.
4. An entry fee will not be payable for any of the Groups or for Best In Show
5. The Groups will be divided into 10 as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules, undefeated winners in the Any Variety Not Classed section may compete in their appropriate Groups for the award of Best In Show.
6. Upon entering the ring competitors must produce their Best of Breed rosettes won on the day.
7. In each Group the Judges shall pick Best of Group, Reserve Best of Group, 3rd and 4th. All absentees must be marked.
8. Winners of Groups will be entitled to compete for the award of Best in Show. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of groups and the reserve winner in the Group from which the winner of Best In Show was picked.
9. If the Group has not commenced before 4.30 p.m, a Best of Breed winner may leave the Show *but* must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group Judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €25, unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging of the Group commences.

# CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The Word 'Dog' Denotes Both Sexes)

In the following definitions any award which counts towards the title of champion under the rules of any Governing Body recognised by the Irish Kennel Club will be regarded as the equivalent of a Green Star. Similarly, the title of Champion is construed as if it were attained under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.

**MINOR PUPPY CLASS** is confined to dogs *over 6 months* and *under 9 months of age* on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

**PUPPY CLASS** is confined to dogs of *over 6 months* and *under 12 months* of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

**JUNIOR CLASS** is confined to dogs of *over 9 months* and *under 18 months* of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

**INTERMEDIATE CLASS** is for dogs between *15* and *24 months* of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth.

**OPEN CLASS** is for all dogs *over 15 months of age* on the day of the Show.

**CHAMPION CLASS** is for dogs which have gained the title of Champion under IKC Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority *confirmed by the closing date of entries.*

**VETERAN CLASS** is for dogs *over eight years of age* on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of its date of birth. A Champion Veteran may enter *either Champion or Veteran but not both.*

**FIELD TRIAL CLASS** where applicable, is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stakes.

**BRACE CLASS** is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in a class other than Brace or Team.

**TEAM CLASS** is for three or more exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in a class other than Brace or Team.

*N.B. A dog or bitch may only be entered on ONE BREED Class only.*

## OBEDIENCE

**Open** is open to all dogs of any breed or variety.

**Beginners** is confined to dogs & handlers who have not won three or more firsts in obedience tests.

**Novice** is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience test with the exception of Beginners.

**Graduate** is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience test with the exception of Beginners and Novice.

**Limit** is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Graduate.

**JUNIOR HANDLERS PLEASE NOTE** The minimum number of points required to qualify for the finals is 17 points (compared to the previous 10 point qualification). It is also a requirement that dogs owned by the member, or member's immediate family or in joint partnership shall be allowed to be handled in competition.

## The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds -  
The American Akita and The Akita Inu.

These breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds, it can only be shown in the appropriate classes. This means that in the future both breeds should be classified in the Show Schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed.

Class 1 Akita Inu            Class 2 American Akita

Class 3 Akita Inu / American Akita (Not Assessed)

At all shows where there are entries of unassessed Akitas, three Assessors on the panel drawn up by the IKC will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the two breeds.

### *N.B. DACHSHUND EXHIBITORS*

From 1st January 2010, there will be classes for assessment in all three coat varieties of Miniature Kanchinen at All Breed Championship Shows. The assessments will be carried out by the Judge elected or Assessor appointed by The Irish Kennel Club.

Dogs for assessment must be 15 months of age or over on the day of the Show.

All dogs must be micro-chipped prior to assessment.

#### *DOGS NOT FOR COMPETITION*

There will be a charge of €5.00 (£4 Stlg) per dog payable before the day of the Show

## DEFINITION OF GRADES

The gradings given by the judges must correspond to the following definitions:

**EXCELLENT** may only be awarded to a dog which comes very close to the ideal standard of the breed, which is presented in excellent condition, displays a harmonious, well-balanced temperament, is of high class and has excellent posture. Its superior characteristics in respect of its breed permit that minor imperfections can be ignored; it must however have the typical features of its sex.

**VERY GOOD** may only be awarded to a dog which possesses the typical features of its breed, which has well-balanced proportions and is in correct condition. A few minor faults may be tolerated but none of a morphological nature. This award can only be granted to a dog that shows class.

**GOOD** is to be awarded to a dog that possesses the main features of its breed however showing faults provided these are not concealed.

**SUFFICIENT** must be awarded to a dog which corresponds adequately to its breed, without possessing the generally accepted characteristics or whose physical condition leaves something to be desired.

**CANNOT BE JUDGED.** This rating is to be given to any dog which does not move, constantly jumps up and down on its handler or tries to get out of the ring, makes it impossible to assess the gait and the movement or avoids constantly to be examined by the judge and makes it impossible to inspect teeth, anatomy and structure, tail or testicles. This rating is also to be given if traces of operations or treatment can be observed which seem to indicate that the exhibitor wanted to deceive the judge.

### **VERY PROMISING**

General appearance: "Very Promising Type" whose merits in structure and conformation are such that it can be considered a very promising specimen of the breed.

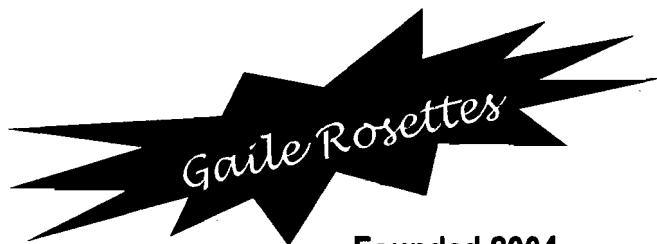
