SHOW REGULATIONS

- **1. Jurisdiction:** The show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club as in force on the 23rd July 2017.
- **2. Registration, etc.:** All dogs entered for competition, or otherwise, must be registered at the Irish Kennel club, Fottrell House, Unit 36, Greenmount office Park, Dublin 6W.
- **3.** Rosettes will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each Class. Cups and trophies will be presented to paid-up members of the Irish Wolfhound Society of Ireland only and are offered under Club conditions.
- 4. **Exhibits:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibits under proper control at all times.
- 5. **Judge:** Judging will commence at **12:00 noon**. In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
- 6. **Interpretation:** All disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the committee. Parties to such a dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.
- 7. **Accident or Damage:** The club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 8. **Veterinary Examination:** The Veterinary Surgeon in attendance will have the power to exclude any exhibit which, in his opinion, is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, vice, lice or other causes.
- 9. Entries: The Committee reserve the right to reject any entry.
- 10. **ENTRY FEES: €20**.00 (£20.00 Stg) for first dog, €7.00 (£7.00 Stg) for second dog in same owner, and €35 (£35.00 Stg) for 3 or more dogs. Stakes classes and Special classes €3.00 (£3.00 Stg) per dog.

Class Definitions (The word dog includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is for dogs over the age of four months and under six months of age on the day of the show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Puppy Class</u> is confined to dogs over six months and under twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Junior Class</u> is for dogs between 9 and 18 months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Intermediate Class</u> is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

<u>Open Class</u> is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

<u>Veteran Class</u> is for dogs of eight years or over on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth

<u>Champion Class</u> is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognized kennel authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

<u>Brace Stakes</u> is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

<u>Team Stakes</u> is for three exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

Please note:

A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>one breed class only</u>. (No double entries) Baby Puppy winners are not eligible to challenge for Green Stars.
