- 1. The show will be held under the Licence, Rules & Regulations of the I.K.C. CLG.
- 2. The show will be held at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin.
- 3. The entry fees will be as follows:

- 4. Border Collie Club of Ireland reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 5. Dogs under 4 months of age are not eligible to enter.
- 6. All dogs must be registered or transferred with the Irish Kennel Club save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club. Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event AND (b) the exhibitor being fined €127 the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6 refundable if the appeal is upheld.
- 7. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
- 8. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
- 9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show grounds is forbidden.
- 10. Judges & Judging:

OBEDIENCE Judging will commence at 10.00am.

BREED Judging will commence at approx. 12.00pm, provided Border Collie judging is completed at Hibernian Ch. Show.

In the event of any judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee of Border Collie Club of Ireland shall have the right to appoint another judge. No person will be allowed in the judging ring except the judge, show officials or an exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication. The exhibit number for each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler. Border Collie Club of Ireland shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.

- 11. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their dog under proper control at all times.
- 12. The catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the committee cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes, which bring the exhibitor within the purview of the I.K.C. CLG., Rule 15, section 1, or for clerical errors that may occur during compilation.
- 13. Exhibitors must clean up if their dog fouls the grounds, suitable facilities will be provided for this. Any exhibitor failing to clean up after their dog will be liable to a €25 fine.
- 14. Border Collie Club of Ireland will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- 15. Ring numbers will be available to download online before the show, or if you have sent your entry by post / handed it in, your ring numbers will be available to collect on the day of the show.

BREED Class Definitions:

Baby Puppy is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition.

<u>Puppy</u> is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 calendar months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Junior</u> is for dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Intermediate</u> is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Adult</u> is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

Open is confined to dogs over 15 months on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

<u>Champion</u> is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.*

<u>Veteran</u> is for dogs over 8 years of age on the day of the show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth. A Veteran dog who has attained the title of Champion may enter the Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

Working To enter a dog in Working Class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation – by the member Country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence – that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test.

OBEDIENCE Class Definitions:

Pre-Beginners Obedience

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded four first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club CLG., Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club CLG.

Beginners Obedience

Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test, other than Pre-Beginners Obedience Class, under Irish Kennel Club CLG., Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club CLG.

Novice Obedience

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

Class A Obedience

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

Class B Obedience

Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club CLG., regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Class A Obedience.

Ch. Class C Obedience is open to all.

Code of Sportsmanship

Irish Kennel Club Sportsmen

- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behaviour.
- The sportsman judge, judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge, or exhibitor, accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the Irish Kennel Clubs byelaws, rules, regulations, and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the Irish Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Note: The term sportsman and sportsmen in this context is gender neutral.
