1. The Show will <u>be held</u> under the rules of The Irish Kennel Club Ltd, as in force on the date of the publication of the schedule and will be on display in an abridged form on the day of the show.

- 3. Catalogue: €5/£5 on the day of the show and prepaid All prepaid catalogues not collected by 12pm will be sold
- 4. Car Park: Prepaid €4/£4 or on the day of the show €5/£5 Dogs registered in partnership or joint owners <u>are treated</u> as separate entries, even when <u>forwarded</u> by single owners. <u>In the event of</u> insufficient information on the entry form an administration fee of €6/ £6 will be automatic in the case of entry fees, in addition there will be a €4 charge plus bank exchange rate charges.

The Hungarian Vizsla Club of Ireland will accept no responsibility for mistakes in the show catalogue which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club rules.

- Prize cards will <u>be given</u> to 1st 2nd 3rd and Reserve. Rosettes will <u>be given</u> to Green Star, Best of Breed, Best Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Veteran in Breed, Group Winners, Reserve Group winners, Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.
- 6. The Entry fee of exhibits <u>failing to arrive</u> or rejected by the veterinary surgeon will <u>be</u> <u>forfeited</u>.

A veterinary surgeon, or an authorised substitute, in attendance will have power to exclude any exhibit which in his/her opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, vice or any other cause.

Judging: (a) Will <u>commence</u> not before 11 am. No claim will <u>be considered in the event</u> <u>of</u> an exhibit being late

(b) No persons will <u>be allowed</u> in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibition number of each dog must <u>be clearly displayed</u> by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the Judging Ring; (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the Ring.

- 7. <u>In the event of a Judge failing to keep his/her engagement, the committee reserves the right to appoint another judge(s).</u>
- Interpretation: The Committee of the HungarianVizsla Club of Ireland within the meaning of the I.K.C. Rules, all disputes, if any, shall <u>be dealt</u> with by the Committee. Parties to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 9. Ineligible Entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to the sex or breed <u>is allowed</u> if reported to the secretary's office prior to the commencing of judging. A dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may <u>be transferred</u> to the open class in that breed, but in no other respects.

- 10. The Hungarian Vizsla Club of Ireland will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.
- 12. All exhibits must be <u>kept on a lead at all times</u>. NOTE: I.K.C. RULE 131
- Re: Registration of Dogs Entered
  Addition to above Rule:
  Failure to <u>comply with</u> the above will result in:
  The Dog <u>being disqualified</u> from the event and
  The exhibitor <u>being fined</u> €130.00

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

- 9. <u>Puppies</u> under the age of 6 months should not be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a baby puppy class is scheduled.
- 10. <u>Exercise/Puppy Pens</u>: are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area at all shows licensed by the Irish Kennel Club.

#### Videos

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.

#### **CLASSIFICATION FOR ALL BREEDS WHERE APPLICABLE**

Dogs: Baby Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Intermediate, Adult, Open, Champion, F/Trial.

Bitches: Baby Puppy, Puppy, Junior, Intermediate, Adult, Open, Champion, F/Trial.

Please Note - All Breeds will have Field Trial Dog and Bitch classes.

**Baby Puppy** Class <u>is confined</u> to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show. Baby Puppies <u>are confined</u> to this class and may not compete for any other award

<u>Puppy Class</u> is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

<u>Champions Class</u> is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of <u>entries.\*</u>\*\*\* A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

<u>FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined</u> to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, <u>Der-</u> by or Open Stake.

<u>Please Note</u>: A Veteran <u>Dog who is a Champion</u> may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

#### Cropped Dogs

Cropped dogs are not <u>permitted</u> to <u>be exhibited</u> at any Irish Kennel Club licensed event.
