SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS

- 1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
- 2. **Date**: The Show will be held on Saturday 10th May 2025 at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin.
- 3. **ENTRY FEES**: The entry fee will be $\in 15.00$ per dog.

ENTERING EXHIBITS: Entries will be received up to and including 18th April 2025 (postmark). Entries must be made on the form issued for this purpose. Entry forms must be completed in ink. Details of entries and fees to be sent to The Secretary, Mr. Sean Campbell, Auburn, Feltrim Road, Swords, Co. Dublin.

ENTRY FORMS: The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.

- 4. **REJECTING ENTRIES**: etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry,
- 5. **REGISTRATIONS**: All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
- 6. **ROSETTES:** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class, to Green Star winners, and Best of Breed, Best Puppy, Best Veteran
- 7. **PRIZES WITHHELD**: A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his (or her) opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- 8. **CATALOGUES**: will be free of charge to exhibitors, otherwise $\notin 2$.
- 9. **JUDGES**: If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge.
- 10. **JUDĞING**:
 - (a) Will commence at 2.00 pm

(b)No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.

- (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor.
- (d) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

FOULING: A minimum fine of $\in 50.00$ shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.

ALL DOGS competing must be on a lead, unless when under a judge.

Dogs:

Baby Puppy Puppy Minor Puppy Junior Intermediate Adult Open Champion Veteran Neutered Dog

Bitches:

Baby Puppy Puppy Minor Puppy Junior Intermediate Adult Open Champion Veteran Neutered Bitch

Neuter Class- will be judged after Best of Breed.

CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word 'Dog' includes both sexes) <u>CLASS DEFINITIONS</u>

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition.

A Minor Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve months of age on the day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between nine and eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

An Adult Class is confined to dogs over 24 and under 36 months of age on the day of the Show.

Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show **

Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries) NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.
