Introduction to Our Judge Mr. John Canty

Prefix: 'Megacant'

John is known very well for his breeding/exhibition of Irish Terriers for the last 40years.

John has bred multiple Irish/UK champions and high winners in his time in Terriers.

John has served on our club committee for many years, supporting and promoting the Irish Terrier breed throughout the years.

We are excited to welcome John as our judge for this years Club Show.

PLEASE NOTE:

It is an Irish Kennel Club Regulation that permission must be sought from the Show Promoting Body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be sought from the Judge in the ring on the day.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- JURISDICTION: The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
 - **VENUE & Date:** The Show will be held at The Farmleigh House, Phoenix Park, Dublin, in conjunction with the Irish Breeds Society Championship Show. 13th September 2025.
- 3. Exhibits: Exhibitors shall be responsible for keeping their dogs under proper control at all times and clean up after their dogs where necessary.
- 4. Entries: €/£20 for the first dog/class. €/£8 for all subsequent entries from same owner. Neutered Classes €2.00 per dog. Classes 16-20 €/£1 per class. Sponsor Rosettes for €/£5 (All Sponsors will be mentioned). Breed Adverts for €/£10.
- Rejection of Entries: The committee reserve the right to reject any entry.
- 6. **Entry Forms**: Mistakes in the Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the exhibitors and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during compilation.
- 7. **Registrations**: All dogs entered for competition must be registered at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- 8. **Ineligible Entries**: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of judging, but in no other respects.
- 9. **Judging:** will commence at 11am, No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. No person will be allowed in the ring except the Judge, Show Officials or an exhibitor taking a dog for adjudication.
- 10. In the event of the appointed judge failing to keep his/her appointment the Committee shall have the right to appoint a substitute.
- The All Ireland Irish Terrier Club while taking every reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of exhibits, will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any exhibit, exhibitor or other person attending the show.
- 12. **Interpretation**: The promoting body shall be the Show Committee and all disputes shall be dealt with by the Show Committee. Parties to any disputes shall have the right to appeal to the Irish kennel Club Ltd.
- Cups and Trophies are confined to fully paid up members. Rosettes are on offer for 1 st,2nd,3rd, and Reserve places in each class, best in Show, reserve Best In Show, Best Veteran, Best Junior and Best Puppy in Show.
- 14. Dogs Not Entered For Competition: Dogs which are not being exhibited at Championship Shows must be entered NOT FOR COMPETITION for insurance purposes, prior to the close of entries. Dogs must be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of

Breed/s and name's of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and

15. **Puppies** under the age of six months should not be present on the show-ground unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BE-FORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION NUMBER ON THE ENTRY FORM.

ENTRY FEES: €/£20 for the first dog/class. €/£8 for all subsequent entries from same owner. Neutered Classes €2.00 per dog. Classes 16-20 €/£1 per class. Sponsor Rosettes for €/£5 (All Sponsors will be mentioned). Breed Adverts for €/£10

Please keep in mind the IKC Rule, if your dog fouls the venue, indoor or outdoor and you fail to clean it up you will be fined £20. The Committee of the All Ireland Irish Terrier Club will strictly enforce this Rule.

CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

**** Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries)

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds unless entered in Baby Puppy Class or Not for Competition. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Dogs entered in restricted classes must also be entered in one of the Standard Classes for the breed. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor

Neuter Class:

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, **BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.**

Registrations
