- 1. The Show will be held under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
- 2. Venue- The Show will be held in the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin Saturday, 12thJuly 2025.

- (b) ENTRY FORMS : MISTAKES IN- The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by the Exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the Forms correctly interpreted, the Irish Ladies Kennel Association cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring Exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15, Sect. 1, or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- **3.** (a) Rejection of Entries: The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, advertisement or any other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of stand space at the show.
- (b) Ineligible Entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class in that breed but in no other respects.
- 4. Registrations: All dogs and Litters entered for competition or otherwise must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club Ltd, Unit 36, Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6 Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted

without futher registration.

- 5. Prizes: Prize Cards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Reserve in each class.Rosettes will be presented to all Best of Breed, Group, Res. Group Winners, Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.
- **6. Prizes Withheld:** A judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes, or Green Stars if in his or her opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
- **7. Special Prizes:** Where special prizes are offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club the Specialist Club will be responsible for the collection and distribution of the prizes
- 8. Exhibits Not Sent:: Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit be rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon, will forfeit the entrance fees paid.
- 9. Veterinary Examination: Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show if: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease; (ii) totally blind or deaf; (iii) castrated (iv)vicious or savage disposition. If requested by the Show Secretary, the Veterinary Surgeon shall give such order in writing, together with the reason for it.
- 10. Opening of the Show: The Show will be open to the public from 8.00a.m. to 6p.m.
- 11. Car Park: €5.00 or £5.00 Stg prepaid or €5.00/£5Stg on Show Day.
- **12.** Stands: Sales of any article will only be permitted to take place from duly licensed stands.
- 13. Catalogues will be on sale within the Showgrounds at €5.00 (£5.00 Stg)
- **14.** Closing of the Show: All exhibits must be removed by the person in charge or by their owners, not later than half an hour after completion of the judging of Best in Show.
- **15.** Judges: If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserve the right to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the Show Committee to change a judge in breed or breeds, or part of a breed, if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the show.
- 16. Judging: Will commence at 10.00 am. sharp. Junior Handling at 9.30am

(a) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.

(b) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration, in the Breed Judging Ring save for the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by his handler.

(c) The following officials of the Show will not be permitted to exhibit there at viz: A Judge, a Veterinary Surgeon, a Steward (except when acting as such in the exception of his duties.)

- **17. Judges Decision:** The decision of a judge at the termination of his or her judging class shall be final, except in the case of objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. where a Judge states that a clerical or other mistake was made in an award as Officially returned, or on the ground of fraud.
- **18. Protest:** All protests and objections must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel Club Ltd. Rules 13, 15, 17.
- **19. Interference with Exhibits:** Any person found interfering with exhibits may render himself liable to forfeit any prizes won.

20. Responsibility:

(a) The Club will not be responsible for loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise

(b) The Club will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the show

- 21. Dogs not entered for competition: Dogs which are not being exhibited at all Breed Championship Shows must be entered as NOT FOR COMPETITION, for insurance purposes, prior to close of entries. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting society giving details of breed/s and name/s of each dog. The show promoting society shall issue a pass or passes to such dogs and keep a record of same. Production of passes may be requested in any area of dispute. The fee for this facility shall be Five Euro, (€5.00), per dog.
- 22. **Puppies under** the age of six (6) months <u>should not</u> be present on the show grounds unless being exhibited where a Baby Puppy class is scheduled.
- 23. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** are prohibited within the confines of the exhibition area, <u>at all</u> <u>shows</u> licensed by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from the 1st January 2009.

Please keep in mind I. K. C. Rule, if your dog fouls the venue indoor or outdoor and you do not clean it up you will be fined €50. This year's committee will strictly enforce this rule.

Save yourself money and clean up after your dog, and at the same time you will be assured of a comfortable venue to show your dog next year.

Exhibitors Please Note

The Committee are most anxious for the care and safety of dogs sent for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the committee will not be responsible for the loss, dentition, or of damage to any dog or property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, or from any act of omission of themselves, their officers, agents or others. Exhibitors are warned to secure their cars and any belongings therein.

Junior Handlers Note:

The minimum number of points required for a Junior Handler to qualify for the finals is now (17) points, compared to the previous ten (10) point qualification. It is also a requirement that only dogs owned by the member, or members immediate family, or in joint partnership shall be allowed to be handled in competition.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed
- **3.** No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in it's breed at the show.
- 4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
- 5. Groups will be divided into ten sections as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
- 6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
- In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place.
- 8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
- 9. If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €100 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences. A Group Winner failing to report for the Best in Show will incur a fine of €100 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

Notice for schedule

The Stakes Classes scheduled at this Show are separate from the Breed Judging and do not come under the rules of the Green Star System, e.g. An exhibit which has been beaten in a Stakes Class but wins Best of Breed may proceed to compete in its relevant Group.

All exhibits who wish to enter Stakes Classes must be entered in their relevant Breed Classes with the exception of Champions/Veterans who may enter the Stakes Class only.

A separate judge other than the Best in Show or Group judge must be used for stakes classes (Best in Show qualified) (effective from the 1st January 2011)

Breeds Not Separately Listed

Breeds entered in the Breeds Not Separately Listed at National Championship Shows will be entered into their appropriate breed class and the breed listed in the Catalogue. A Judge may award a Green Star and Best of Breed in each breed to any dog unbeaten and eligible, if in his/ her opinion they are of sufficient quality and graded excellent or in the case of puppies "Very Promising" Effective from 1st January 2011.

Cropped Dogs

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the first day of the show.

Baby Puppies are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Baby Puppy in Show

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.****

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.)

FIELD TRIAL CLASS is confined to dogs that have won at least a reserve in a Novice, Puppy, Derby or Open Stake.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.**


N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries) BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to

the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibitor.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, **BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars** and **there is no Neuter Champion title.**



The Japanese Akita

The Japanese Akita as a breed no longer exists. There are now two breeds; Akita Inu and American Akita - both these breeds have their own standards. Once a dog has been assessed as being of either of the two breeds it can be shown in the appropriate classes.

This means that in future both breeds should be classified in the schedule and there should be an identical classification for those dogs yet to be assessed. (Class 1 Akita Inu, Class 2 American Akita and Class 3 Akita Inu/American Akita (not yet assessed) At all shows where there are entries of un assessed Akita's three of the assessors on the panel drawn up by the Irish Kennel Club will be asked to attend and divide the dogs prior to the judging of the breeds.

<u>Videos</u>

It is a Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of video or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring on the day.
