### **Show Regulations**

- <u>Jurisdiction</u>: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club CLG as in force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2025.
- Venue: The Show will take place at The National Show Centre, Cloghran, Swords, Co. Dublin, on Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> May 2025
- 3. Entry Fees: €25.00 1<sup>st</sup> dog for First Class. Baby Puppy €15.00 per dog. Subsequent entries: €15.00 per dog per class. Any number of dogs €50 (registered to the same owner). Other Classes: €5.00 per dog per class.
- 4. Entries: will be received by the Secretary up to 2<sup>nd</sup>May 2025.
  Online will close at midnight on the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025
- 5. Rejection of entries: The committee reserves the right to reject any entry advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue.
- 6. Ineligible entries: A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex may be allowed by the secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in a class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class in that breed but in no other respects.
- 7. Registrations: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club CLG., Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6.
- 8. Entry Forms: Mistakes in: The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by the exhibitors and while every Endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted the Labrador Retriever Club of Ireland cannot accept responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club CLG. Rule 15, Section 1 or clerical mistakes that may occur during the compilation
- 9. **Judging:** Judging will commence in all rings at 11 30 am. sharp.
- 10. **Judges:** In the event of the appointed Judge failing to keep his/her engagement the committee reserve the right to employ the services of another judge.
- 11. The promoting Body will not be responsible for any loss damage or accident to any person, property or dog in the show or attending same.

### CLASS DEFINITIONS (The word "Dog" includes both sexes)

A **Baby Puppy Class** is confined to puppies of four months of age and under six months of age on the day of the show.

Baby puppies are confined to this class and cannot compete for any further awards.

A **Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

A Minor Puppy Class is confined to dogs of 6 months and under the age of 9 months on the day of the Show.

A **Junior Class** is confined to dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**An Adult Class** is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An **Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the first day of the Show.

A **Champion Class** is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority **confirmed by the date of closing of entries.**\*\*\*\*

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the first day of the Show.

**Field Trial Class** is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations. (Compulsory at All Breed Championship Shows for Groups 7 & 8)

**Special Beginners:** To be eligible to compete in this class, neither the owner, handler or dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the Show. In the event of co-owned dogs, all owners must fulfil the criteria. This class is judged on the quality of the dog. .

**Neuter Class;** The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show. **BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.** 

A Breeders Class is for a minimum of three and a maximum of five exhibits of the same breed and variety without distinction of sex bred by the same person (same kennel name) even if they are not his/her property.

A progeny Class is for a sire or dam with a minimum of three and a maximum of five of his/her progeny, / 1st generation sons/daughters.
