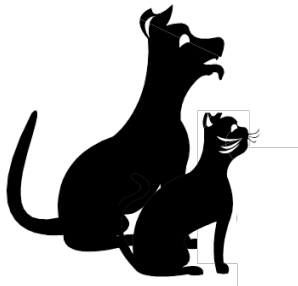

1. **Rules:** The Show will be held under the rules of The Irish Kennel Club as in force on the date of the publication of this schedule and will be on display on the day of the show.
2. **Venue:** The show will be held on the grounds of Ards Rugby Club Lansdowne Road Newtownards.
3. **The Entry Fees:** Will be as follows:

- 4. Rejection of Entries etc.** The Promoting Body reserves the right to refuse any entry, advertisement or other insertions in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand Space at the show.
- 5. Entry Forms;** The catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms or on-line entries submitted by the exhibitors, and while every endeavour will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, Newtownards and District Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd Rule 15 (Sec. 1) or Clerical Mistakes that may occur during the compilation.
- 6. Ineligible Entries:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to Sex or Breed maybe allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class if applicable in that breed but in no other respects.
- 7. As there is** no entry fee charged, there will be no prize money. Rosettes will be given to the following; Green Star Winner, CACIB Winners, Best in Breed Puppy Winners, Best Veteran in Breed Winners, Best of Breed, Group placements from 1st to 4th. Best in Show 1st to 4th, Best Puppy in Show 1st to 4th, Best Baby Puppy in Show 1st to 4th, Best Veteran in Show 1st to 4th, Best Neutered in Show 1st to 4th, Best Native Breed in Show 1st to 4th.
- 8. Exhibits:** (a) Each exhibitor shall be responsible for keeping their exhibit under proper control at All Times; (b) Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 7pm on the day of the show.
- 9. Judges:** In the event of an appointed judge failing to keep his/her engagement the committee shall have the right to appoint another judge(s).
- 10. Judging:** (a) Judging will commence at **09:30am Sharp**. No claim will be considered in the event of an exhibit being late. (b) No persons will be allowed in the Judging Ring except the Judge, Show Officials or and Exhibitor taking a dog for adjudication. (c) The exhibit number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other identifying decoration in the judging ring. (d) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring.
- 11. Special Prizes:** Offered by a Special Club or Individual must be collected from Newtownards and District Canine Club on the day of the show.
- 12. All Announcements:** In respect of any change to the original advertised Show Information etc. may be found on the Club's Social Media Page and where applicable on other formats. This will be deemed as sufficient notice thereof.
- 13. Interpretation:** The Committee of the promoting club shall be the 'Show Committee' within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Rules; All disputes, if any, shall be dealt with by the committee. Parts to any dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club.

14. **Accidents or Damage:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
15. **Exercise/Puppy Pens:** Are prohibited within the confines of the Exhibition Area, **at All Shows** licenced by the Irish Kennel Club with effect from 1st January 2009.
16. **Dogs Not Entered for Competition:** Dogs which are not being exhibited at All Breed Championship Shows must be entered as **Not for Competition**, for insurance purposes, prior to the close of entry. Dogs to be entered on a form supplied by the show promoting body, giving details of the Breed(s) and the Name(s) of each dog. The show promoting body shall issue a Pass(s) to such dogs and will keep a record of same. Production of passes maybe requested in any area of dispute. A fee for this facility shall be Five Euros, (€5:00) per dog.
17. **Puppies Under:** the age of Six (6) Months **should not** be present on the showgrounds unless being exhibited in a scheduled Baby Puppy Class.

Section (1) Rule 7 Registration

Every dog exhibiting or competing at any Show, Field Trial or Obedience Test, must be registered with the Irish kennel Club in the name of exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhound duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dogs not of a recognised breed for which licenses have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Test.

Failure to comply with the above will result bin (a) The dog being disqualified from the event and (b) the exhibitor being fined €127:00 – the implementation of which shall be a normal Office routine. All appeals to the Irish kennel Club should carry a fee of €6:00, refundable if the appeal is upheld.

Cropped Dogs: Cropped dogs are not permitted to be exhibited at any Irish kennel Club licenced event.

Exhibitors Please Note

The Committee are most anxious for the care and safety of dogs sent for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them but it must be distinctly understood by the exhibitors and all other persons, that the committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog or property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, or from any act of omission of themselves, their officers, agents or others. Exhibitors are warned to secure their cars and any belongings therein.

Additional Information

Fouling: please keep in mind IKC Rule: if your dog fouls anywhere within the venue and you do not clean up you will be fined the appropriate amount as levelled by the IKC at the time of the show. The committee will strickle enforce this rule; anyone not complying with their request or directions to clean up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave the venue forthwith. Save yourself money and cleanup after your dog, ensuring the retention of our venue for future shows.

Admission Time to Venue: Gates will open at 7:30 am on the morning of the show. Overnight Parking will be available on Friday 31st July 2026 access for this will be from 5pm until 9pm. Gates to the venue will be secured at 9pm. Overnight Parking must be prebooked either on-line with entries or directly to the Show Secretary. Catering will be available throughout the day of the show

Catalogues: There will be no printed catalogues available at this show; a free Online catalogue will be available on the morning of the show downloadable at www.dogshowentry.ie

Exhibitors Number & Passes: Will be available to download before the show at www.dogshowentry.ie An email will be sent to each exhibitor when Numbers and Passes etc. are available to download.

Late Entries: No Entries will be taken after the Final Close of Entry date. This will be stickily adhered too.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

1. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Promoting Body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed.
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. to 4th place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If your Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise, all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over four and under six months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition other than Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over six and under nine months of age on the day of the Show. **(Puppies may not compete for the Green Star or CACIB)**

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show. **(Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB but may compete for the Green Star)**

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

Open Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show. **Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to compete for the CACIB)**

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

Working Class To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate containing the confirmation -by the member country in which the holder and/or owner has his permanent place of residence- that the dog has passed the test as well as details about this test. The only breeds eligible for the working class are those appearing as working breeds in the FCI Breed Nomenclature, taking into account the exceptions granted to some countries for some breeds.

Neuter Class;

The classes can be offered at all Championship & Open Shows in the breed and the Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and go forward to Best Neuter in Show, BUT they do not compete for the Green Stars and there is no Neuter Champion title.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit

OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS

PRE -BEGINNERS Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded two first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Limited Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club Limited. Handlers will not be penal-ised for encouragement or extra commands except in the sit and down stay tests. In these stay tests handlers will face their dogs. Judge or Steward may not use the words 'Last Command' except in the sit and down stay tests.

BEGINNERS Confined to dogs or handlers which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or awarded three or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks) in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

NOVICE Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience class other than in Beginners Obedience class.

CLASS (A) OBEDIENCE (GRADUATE) Confined to dogs which have not been awarded an Obedience Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Class other than in Beginners and Novice Obedience classes.

CLASS (B) OBEDIENCE (LIMIT) Confined to dogs which have not been awarded a Green Star or four or more first prizes (on or under 10 marks under Irish Kennel Club regulations) in any Obedience Classes with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Graduate Obedience classes.

CLASS © CH. OBEDIENCE (OPEN) Open to all.
