CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Adult Class is for dogs between 24 and 36 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.*

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

BRACE CLASS is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

Neuter Class: Neutered Male and Neutered Female are confined to this class can compete for Best Neuter In Breed and go forward to Best Neuter In Show (they may not compete for the Green Star)

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in <u>ONE BREED CLASS ONLY</u> (No double entries) Please Note

Champions can now be entered in the Champion Class at Open Shows in each Breed, but can only compete for Best Champion in Sex, Best Champion in Breed and Best Champion in Show (This is similar to the Baby Puppies)

Please Keep the Venue Clean

Neuter Classes: Can be offered at All Championship & Open Shows in the Scheduled Breeds. The Best Neuter Male and Best Neuter Female can compete for Best Neuter in Breed and can go forward to compete in Best Neuter in Show: Neuter Classes will be scheduled for after each respective Breed of Breed.

Show Regulations

- Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd as in force on the 01 January, 2025.
- Registration etc: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
- 3) Venue: Newtownards Rugby Club, Lansdowne Road Newtonwards
- 4) Catalogues: Free online Catalogue available at Show with each entry.
- 5) Entries: Service Charge of £10 or €10 for the first dog. £5 or €5 will be payable for all subsequent dogs or classes.
- 6) Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- Stakes Classes: £5 or €5 extra for , Puppy Stakes, Veteran Stakes and Junior Handling (Junior Handling Classes Free if entered in Breed)
- 8) Rejecting Entries: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue.
- 9) Ineligible Entries: If before judging of a Class or Classes in which his dog is entered an exhibitor reports that he has entered the dog in a Class for which he is not eligible, he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the Open Class but in no other circumstances can a change be made.
- Entry Forms (Mistakes therein): The Catalogue will be compiled from he entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
- 11) Entries Close Postal 5th May 2025 (Postmark) Enter online at www.dogshowentry.ie Online entry closes at midnight on the 5th May 2025
- 12) Rosettes: Best of Breed Winners, Group 1-4, Best in Show 1-4, Stakes 1-4, Junior Handling 1-4
- 13) **Veterinary Examination**: The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the authority to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, lice or any other cause.

14) NO PRIZE MONEY ON OFFER AT THIS SHOW Exhibits:

- 15) Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times.
- 16) Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent no later than 6pm.
- 17) Judging: All Judging will commence at 11:00 am. Sharp
- 18) No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
- 19) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except for the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication.
- 20) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.
- 21) The Club shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- 22) A judge's decision shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club, or where a Judge states that a clerical or other error was made in the award as Officially returned, or on the grounds of fraud.
- 23) Sale of Dogs: Exhibitors may state on their entry form the price at which they are prepared to sell particular exhibits.
- 24) Any amendments or alterations being made by the Committee to the Show will be notified to exhibitors wherever possible and this shall be deemed as sufficient notice.
- 25) The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or others attending the Show.
- Junior Handling: The dog must be the bona fide property of the family of the junior handler. Nominate the junior handler on the entry form also his/her age. The age of the handler on the 1st January is the age to be taken for the rest of the year when entering.
