About me I was born in 1973 in Rijeka in doggy family.

I was keen on hunting dogs always, so that in mid-80 our family expanded for one member, which was an English Cocker Spaniel who founded my love towards the cynology. I became active in the cynology in late 80's, as a member of SKK Rijeka. In that same club I gained first experience by volunteering and organizing various events.

I continued to educate myself further and I got my judging license firstly for breeds of FCI Group VIII (judge from 1993) and later for FCI Group VII and IV as well as part of Group II and part of Group VI.

I am also licensed to judge work of Pointing dogs, Spaniels and Leash hounds. I used to visit many shows abroad, especially in UK, where I first saw the breed which I decided to have myself. It was a Clumber Spaniel which we got in 1993 and since then my love towards this wonderful breed is constantly increasing. My dogs have won many national and international titles, World and European titles, group placements and BIS and BISS.

The crown of my breeding achievement is to win BOB with my own dog, bred by me at the Club Show Championship show in Great Britain land of the Clumber Spaniels, also followed by winning BOB at Cruft's looking forward for some more good results, but they are primarily my pets.

Now I have 6 Clumbers which I am co-owning together with my sister, our kennel prefix is HROTHGAR'S.

In 2010, we imported Hungarian Vizsla, a breed completely different in character but which brought a lot of life into our family.

Dachshunds are second biggest love who took my heart. I have judged on various events in Croatia, Slovenia, Austria, Italy, Finland, San Marino, Belgium and Denmark.

Show Regulations

- 1) Jurisdiction: The Show will be held under the Licence and Rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd as in force on 1st January 2025
- 2) Registration etc: All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club.
- 3) **Venue: Eikkon Exhibition Centre, Balmoral Park, Halftown Road, Lisburn, Co. Antrim, BT27 5RF**
- 4) Catalogues: will be on sale within the show grounds, priced €1 or £1
- 5) **Entries: Entry Fee for Members €20 (£20) for the first dog. €10 (£10) for all subsequent dogs or classes. €60.00 (£60.00) for 5 or more entries**
Non Members €25.00 (£25.00) for first and €12.50 (£12.50) second entry
Membership €5.00 (£5.00) see form page 7
- 6) Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge, which cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- 7) Rejecting Entries: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue.
- 8) Ineligible Entries: If before judging of a Class or Classes in which his dog is entered an exhibitor reports that he has entered the dog in a Class for which he is not eligible, he may be permitted to transfer his entry to the Open Class but in no other circumstances can a change be made.
- 9) Entry Forms (Mistakes therein): The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every effort will be made to have the forms correctly interpreted, the promoting body cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.
- 10) **Entries Close 14th September 2025 (Postmark) Online closes midnight 19th September 2025**
- 11) Rosettes: Green Star Dog and Bitch, Best of Breed, Res. Best of Breed, Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Show 1-4, Best Puppy in Show 1-4, Best Baby Puppy In Show, Best Neuter in Show, Best Veteran in Show
- 12) Veterinary Examination: The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the authority to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of disease, lice or any other cause.
- 13) No Prize money on offer at this show.
- 14) Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibit under proper control at all times.
- 15) Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent no later than 6pm.
- 16) **Judging: Judging will commence after Belfast Dog Show judging Classes**
- 17) No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
- 18) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except for the Judge, Show

Officials, or an Exhibitor taking a dog in for adjudication.

- 19) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.
- 20) The Club shall not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
- 21) A judge's decision shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club, or where a Judge states that a clerical or other error was made in the award as officially returned, or on the grounds of fraud.
- 22) Sale of Dogs: Exhibitors may state on their entry form the price at which they are prepared to sell particular exhibits.
- 23) Any amendments or alterations being made by the Committee to the Show will be notified to exhibitors wherever possible and this shall be deemed as sufficient notice.
- 24) The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or others attending the Show.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

A Baby Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 4 and under 6 months of age on the day of the Show. Dogs entered in this class are not eligible to challenge for the Green Star and may not take part in any further competition except Best Baby Puppy In Show.

A Puppy Class is confined to dogs from six to twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Junior Class is for dogs between 9 and 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Intermediate Class is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

An Open Class is for dogs over 15 calendar months of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Champions Class is for dogs who have gained the Title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under a recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.*

A Veteran Class is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show, computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

A Neuter Class is for sterilised dogs over 4 calendar months of age on the day of

the show. Neutered dogs are confined to this class and may not compete for any other award other than Best Neuter in Show

Special Beginners Stakes –neither the owner, handler or dog will have won a Green Star prior to the entry closing date of the Show. In the event of co-owned dogs, all owners must fulfil the criteria. This class is judged on the quality of the dog. No entry fee but dogs must have been entered in a breed class.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY

**Please keep in mind the IKC Rule, if your dog fouls the venue,
indoor or outdoor and you fail to clean it up you will be fined €25.**

The Committee will strictly enforce this Rule.

Exhibitors Please Note

The Committee are most anxious for the care and safety of dogs sent for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to them but it must be distinctly understood by exhibitors and all other persons that the committee will not be responsible for the loss, dentition, or of damage to any dog or property, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever, or from any act of omission of themselves, their officers, agents or others. Exhibitors are warned to secure their cars and any belongings therein.
